
Dear Resident/Alumnus (a):

• In 2011, North Attleboro was one of three schools to have the Highest MCAS scores in 10th grade Science.

Advanced Placements

- Student AP enrollment has increased from 104 students in 2009 to 207 students in 2013; this is a 99% increase.
- The number of AP Exams administered at our school has increased from 144 exams in 2009 to 355 exams in 2013; this is a 147% increase.
- The number of qualifying AP Scores earned by our students has increased from 78 in 2008 to 113 in 2012; this is a 45% increase.
- The increased enrollment has led to the district's selection to the AP District Honor Roll.
- NAHS is one of 18 schools in the state that have qualified for an AP Stem Access
 Program that provides funding for new Advanced Placement math and science courses and is funded from a grant from Google.
- North Attleboro High School is the only school in the state selected for both the AP District Honor Roll and the AP Stem Access Program.

Science Lab Grant

 NAHS is the proud recipient of a \$6M grant for the renovation of the NAHS science labs, the first major upgrade to the school since it was built in 1973. The project is expected to be completed in September 2013 and will include 12 state-of-the-art science labs with new furniture and technology.
